AS EXAM RESULTS AND PROGRESSION INTO YEAR 13

As we finally arrive at the start of the summer holiday, I would just wish to remind you and your son of the arrangements for the collection of his AS results on 14th August.

AS Results may be collected from the Queen's Hall at 11.30am

Should you be unable to collect them at this time, they may be collected from the Examinations Office the following morning. Included within the results envelope is a reply slip asking your son to confirm his choice of A2 subjects. It is vital he return this as soon as possible to the School Office, so that we can include him in the relevant classes.

The RGS sets a minimum AS grade requirement for progression into Year 13. **Each student must achieve at least a D grade score in the three subjects he wishes to pursue at A level in order to continue into Year 13.** Should your son's results fall below this requirement, either yourselves or your son must contact Mrs Allfrey, his Head of Year, immediately. Mrs Allfrey will then arrange to meet with you.

I very much hope that all our Year 12 students receive the AS results they hope for, and are able to enjoy a long and enjoyable summer break.
