Acceptance of Gifts Policy

The Wycombe Royal Grammar School Foundation is a charity registered in England and Wales for the purpose of providing benefit for the Royal Grammar School, including the provision of boarding accommodation for existing pupils and to promote the education of present and former pupils of the School who are in need.

To further our mission of providing the best education, the Foundation Trustees accept charitable gifts from donating parties under strict guidelines:

**Gifts may be presented to the Foundation Trust as:**

Cash sums (either in full or as pledged payments)  
Stocks, shares, bonds  
Legacy gifts and life insurance policy disbursements  
Gifts in Kind  
Property and/or land (with full documentation)

The Foundation Trustees will refuse any gift, financial or otherwise, that we believe is incompatible with our mission or charitable purposes in support of an educational establishment.

**Gifts that are prohibited by the Foundation Trustees include:**

Revenue generated from the pornographic industry  
Revenue generated from illegal substances  
Gifts for which a service is expected or implied in return  
Gifts for which there are conditions attached that cannot be met through the activities and processes of the School, its Governing Body or Foundation Trustees  
Items of national and/or international historical importance for which ownership may be disputed  
Any other gift for which ownership or legality could be disputed  
Gifts of money or items of significant financial value to individual members of the Foundation or the School

**Gifts that may be accepted at the discretion of the Foundation Trustees include:**

Gifts from religious organisations/figures  
Gifts from political organisations/figures

These guidelines are intended to provide general guidance. They are not inclusive or exhaustive and are subject to change at the discretion of the Foundation Trustees at any time.
