Married parents have equal parental responsibility. On separation or divorce both parents continue to have responsibility. In such circumstances, provided that the School is duly notified of the change in circumstances, the School will forward copies of School reports to the parent with whom the boy does not live as his main residence, in addition to the parent with whom he shares primary residence.

The Royal Grammar School is in a unique position in Buckinghamshire in that it has a Boarding provision attached to the school. **Bucks County Council carries out the selection procedure for 182 day places and the Royal Grammar School handles the admissions for the 10 boarding places.**

Weekly Boarding is offered on a five year basis i.e. Year 7 through to Year 11, and boarding places cannot be converted to Day places.

The testing carried out by the Royal Grammar School for boarding places is exactly the same as the Buckinghamshire County Council 11+ Transfer Testing Procedure. A Familiarisation leaflet will be available in good time before the test dates for your son to work through in advance.

The transfer tests are of 45-50 minutes duration, and must be taken on the same day. If you have opted for your son to be tested at the Royal Grammar School, full details of the dates and arrangements for testing will be forwarded to you in due course. Your son will also be invited to sit two preparation tests on a separate day prior to the actual tests. This will give your son the opportunity to work through example test questions and to give him experience of test-taking conditions.

All boarding applications should be made direct to the school which will be the main information point for parents regarding boarding applications and procedures. You must also specify your preference for a boarding place on your Common Application Form (CAF). If you simply list 'Royal Grammar School' as a preference, it will be assumed by the Local Authority that you are applying for a normal day place, if you wish to apply for a boarding place (weekly boarding), you must specify 'Royal Grammar School Boarding' on the Common Application Form. The Royal Grammar School will inform parents, before 1 March, if a boarding place is to be offered.

Please attach a photocopy of your son's passport to this registration form. This is a Home Office requirement and your application cannot be considered without it. All boarders must have right of residency in the UK or a current British or EU Passport to qualify for a boarding place.
