Ski Trip 14-22 February 2020
Killington, Vermont, USA, plus New York stopover
Price: £1950

We are delighted to announce the launch of our latest USA ski trip for Years 10-13 pupils, which will run at February half-term in 2020. We will once again be travelling with Equity, a company that has provided excellent service and support in the past. Please take time to look at the company website www.equity.co.uk.

Killington, Vermont, is the largest ski area in the eastern U.S with a huge range of fantastic skiing. As an East Coast resort, it reduces flight time and jet lag for our students and, of course, offers the opportunity to visit New York City on our return home. We will be staying at the [Killington Mountain Lodge](#).

The main details of the trip are summarised below:

- **Accommodation** - 6 nights hotel accommodation in Killington, breakfast and evening meal, one night in New York, breakfast and evening meal
- **Lift pass** - 5 day lift pass for the full ski area of Killington
- **Return travel** - from school to the resort by executive coach and plane
- **Tuition** – 5 days snowsport course including 5 hours tuition per day by fully qualified English speaking instructors
- **Ski/snowboard and boot hire**
- **Après-ski activities** – local ice hockey game, snowtubing, cinema, bowling
- **Insurance** - Comprehensive winter sports insurance, both through the School and Equity
- **A stopover in New York** - shopping trip, possible Yankees Stadium, World Trade Centre, Rockefeller Centre, to be decided, but jam-packed!

There are 40 pupil places, which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis; to ensure fairness this trip will launch on ParentPay one week from today. We would not want any pupil to not be able to take advantage of this opportunity due to financial reasons. Deposits, via ParentPay, are required by **Friday 14th December 2018**. Alternatively, please give your son a deposit cheque made payable to RGS High Wycombe, for £300, and ask him to take it to the Finance Office in School House. Please note, where the School is required to make non-refundable payments to a trip provider, we will not be able to make any refunds should your son be selected for the trip and subsequently wish to withdraw. To assist you with budgeting, can I remind you that there is an overview of all trips available to your son during his time at RGS on the School website.
