Morrisby Online Profiling at home

One of the toughest challenges that students face is knowing which pathways they would find fulfilling and what potential they have. As part of their progression post-16 or post-18, we are coordinating the Morrisby Online Profiling facility for students in Years 10, 11, 12 and 13.

Morrisby Online is a Psychometric Testing & Guidance tool that helps students identify potential progression paths and make informed decisions about their study options. Participating students will take an online assessment (in the form of a battery of tests) **at home in their own time**. These tests measure a variety of elements including career interests, work attitudes, talents and motivations. Once the assessment is complete, students will have access to personally tailored career and education suggestions, plus a wealth of careers-related resources. The cost of this **optional** service and subscription to the service is £30 per student (paid directly to Morrisby). Students will have access to Morrisby for life with the ability to revise the profile and seek support over time using the resources available on the tool.

How to sign up for the test

Please click on [this](#) link which will be valid for use until **Friday 15th May 2026**. Please make sure your child's school email address is used.

Upon payment, an email will be sent to the purchaser giving them a username and password for their child which can be used immediately. Once they have these details the student will need to go to www.morrisby.com and 'Log in' in the top right-hand corner of the screen using their username and password to get access to the initial screen they need to complete prior to taking the assessments. From here they will be guided through the process. The Morrisby Profile does not need to be taken at any particular time and does not need to be completed in one session.

We would not like any student to be prevented from signing up for purely financial reasons.
