## Year 13 Post Easter Plans

I wrote to you immediately after the break to share our post Easter Plans. As promised, I write with further details on the Eton X week and the Preparation for University/Work/Apprenticeship programme we have devised.

Eton X: week commencing 4 May

EtonX (<a href="https://etonx.com/">https://etonx.com/</a>) creates innovative online courses and software for teenagers to develop the skills they need to thrive in a rapidly changing world. Its *Future Skills Programme* is a series of short online courses designed to equip young people with the practical, entrepreneurial and transferable skills they need for university entrance and a successful career beyond.

During this period Eton have kindly made their courses freely available for schools. We have been offered one free course for Year 13. The course our students will enrol on is the Creative Problem-Solving Course. We feel this is the most relevant to all members of the year group. By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Develop curiosity for creative problem-solving
- Generate lots of ideas
- Be playful with their ideas
- Refine and develop their ideas
- Take risks and learn from mistakes
- Persist with creative ideas
- Develop their visual and verbal creativity
- Be brave enough to share their creative ideas

It will require 7-10 hours of self-study following the online resources. We would therefore expect students to complete the course during the week. Mr Noyes will be tracking their progress and celebrating their success.

- 5. Congratulations! You can now get started on your course.
