Year 12 – UCAT Training Day - Thursday 14th May

On Thursday, 14th May, Y12 aspiring Medics/Dentists will be able to take part in UCAT entry exam Training. The workshop provider, an annual guest who will come into school, is extremely experienced and always receives great feedback from students who take part.

Students will gain valuable insight into the structure of the test, effective strategies for tackling each section, and tips on how to improve their performance. There will also be interactive practice sessions to enhance their problem-solving and critical-thinking skills. The preparation is even more important as last year's UCAT exam has been modified. There will be no changes to students' normal times of the day, just that they will be off-timetable in this UCAT full-day workshop.

Any Year 12 students intending to apply for medicine, dentistry or other UCAT-requiring courses should take part by completing the ParentPay payment process of £110 (an amount which is considerably more competitive than the wider providers out there).
