## RGS Musical 2024: Shrek the Musical

After hugely successful performances of *The Producers* in March, the RGS Music Department is delighted to announce exciting plans for a whole school production of *Shrek the Musical*, to be staged in the Queen's Hall (Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> – Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2024). We have selected this show in part to contrast with our previous RGS musicals and in order to provide plenty of opportunities for students to audition and gain a huge amount of experience, regardless of whether they have performed on stage before or not.

This show is open to all years, with a range of opportunities for both senior and junior students to have featured roles. It is a fun, family musical, telling the story of a green ogre and his adventures after meeting a group of fairytale characters, leading him on a quest to rescue Princess Fiona. *Shrek the Musical* transforms the contemporary children's book and popular animated feature film into a stage musical that is sure to entertain and make audiences believe in happy endings for all.

I am delighted to work alongside Becky Harrison, a professional director and choreographer, who has directed our previous productions of *The Producers, School of Rock, In The Heights*, and *West Side Story*, whilst also being heavily involved in the local Trinity Theatre Arts school that takes place onsite.

Auditions will be held at RGS in the Queen's Hall on two days, so please attend the relevant slot for your year group on either Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October, or Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October. There is no advantage to choosing either date:

- 10:30-12:45 Years 7-9 singing, acting and movement audition
- 12:45-1:15 Years 7-9 optional character dancer audition
- 2:15-4:30 Years 10-11 singing, acting and movement audition
- 4:30-5:30 Years 10-13 optional featured dancer audition
- 5:30-7:30 Years 12-13 singing, acting and movement audition
