Dear Parents,

I hope that this letter finds you and your family well, and that your son has found the EtonX and other online courses useful and enjoyable. We would be grateful if you could note the important information below.

This year, A Level Results Day falls on Thursday 13th August and we will be emailing A Level results for all students to their school email addresses at 8am that day. It is vital, therefore, that your son is able to access his school account and that he tests it in advance of Results Day. We recommend that he does this now to check his logins are correct, and then again a few days before Results Day just to make sure he has access. If he has forgotten his login details or has any other difficulties accessing his account, he should email ithelp@rgshw.com as soon as possible to resolve the issue.

Although we anticipate there will be many students who choose not to come into school on Results Day, the Queen's Hall will be open as usual so that students can collect their grades in person, if they wish to do so. Senior staff will be on hand to welcome them in with appropriate physical-distancing measures in place.

The Queen's Hall will be open from 8am, with students allocated a time slot according to surname. The time slots are as follows:

- 8am – 8.30am: students with surnames beginning with the letters A – G
- 8.30am – 9am: students with surnames beginning with the letters H – M
- 9am – 9.30am: students with surnames beginning with the letters N – Z

We would kindly ask you to stick to these time slots to prevent crowding on the site. Entry to the site will be via the Quad gate. We would also appreciate it if your son did not bring more than one family member with him when he comes onto site.

Please note that we will not be giving out results over the phone.
