### **Morrisby Online At RGS**

Y11-13 Students | 10<sup>th</sup> March, 1600-1800, G1 and G4 | Register and pay online | Bring your laptop or iPad

The Morrisby Online version is the foremost careers diagnostic tool available to anyone, student or adult, who wishes to identify the career opportunities most appropriate for them. It uses a series of assessments, which look at aptitudes, interests and work/study orientated personality to produce a comprehensive report that is then personalised further by a one to one feedback and guidance session. The on line report suggest careers, 'A' level and degree choices, which might suit the pupil.

The Morrisby '**online**' version is approximately two hours long (the ability sections are timed but the aspiration questionnaire, which assesses careers interests and personality elements can take students different lengths of time). Please note students need a reading age of at least 12 years old to feel confident with Morrisby. The earliest stage a pupil can do this test is the last term of Year 10.

Adviza, the Careers Guidance Company we work with, is offering our students the opportunity to take this assessment in school and have the follow up advice to help their decision-making for the future.

Adviza qualified Careers Advisers will feedback the report to the students at a later date, which will be confirmed after the assessment is done. This will help them consider what it means to them and what their next steps might be. Although each candidate can print out their report if they want, it remains available online and students can use their test login to go back to it and use the library of related information that are attached to continue exploring their ideas, for as long as they want.

### **What is the cost?**

The cost of the online Morrisby package is £99 including feedback/guidance.

There is a bursary available to fund Morrisby places for those whose family income is below £26,000 gross (you may be asked for evidence of this at a later stage). You can email your form back to Adviza and once your bursary is approved, we will make the booking for you, and you will receive a confirmation email.
