CRICKET SEASON 2026

With Spring starting to bloom the cricket season is just around the corner and I wanted to take this opportunity to share various information with you all ahead of the school cricket season in the Summer Term.

GAMES

Pupils will be choosing their Summer Term Games options before the end of this term.

In cricket we will do a mixture of nets, skill development, scenario-based games and both external and internal fixtures. This caters for all abilities at all ages with groupings based on ability to ensure a fun and safe environment for all where each pupil can develop.

AFTER SCHOOL CRICKET

After school cricket will run throughout the Summer Term from 3:45pm - 5pm. It is open to everyone who is doing cricket as their Games option. The schedule is as follows:

CRICKET EQUIPMENT

Cricket equipment is expensive, and therefore an investment, which not everyone will be willing to or able to make. That is not a problem though as we have hard ball kits for pupils to borrow for Games sessions and in fixtures.

RGS PLAYING KIT

A, B and C team fixtures will be played in whites, while D team fixtures will be played in RGSHW PE kit. RGSHW cricket whites are available to buy from [Hawkinsport](#) however, they are not compulsory.

T20 coloured kits for Senior teams (and Junior teams when required) will be provided by the school so there is no requirement to purchase these items - although you can if you want your own kit to play in and keep.

SELECTION POLICY

The overall aim of cricket at RGS High Wycombe is to provide a range of training and match opportunities and experiences for as many pupils as possible. These opportunities and experiences will enable RGSHW pupils to develop and become well-rounded cricketers. In turn, the pupils will be prepared for cricket beyond school and able to pursue a lifelong passion for the sport. Please read through the [Selection Policy](#) ahead of the season.

GUIDANCE

We welcome the support of parents and carers in watching your child play cricket for RGS, and representing the school. However, this does present RGS with logistical challenges with visitors on site during the normal working school day. We ask that parents park on Uplyme and sign in at the main School House reception (the building with two white pillars directly in front of the pedestrian access gate) Please only arrive **after 2.15pm**. Please do not arrive before this time as we will not be able to accommodate you on site. Please note the toilet facilities cannot really be utilised during the school day. If you are arriving after 2.15pm and before the end of the school day you will need to be signed into the school site and escorted to the cricket pitches. Unfortunately, we cannot allow parents to enter the school before 2.15pm for safeguarding reasons.
