Dear Year 8 Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to confirm that the English Department has booked an in-house performance of *Romeo and Juliet* by the travelling theatre company [the Globe Players](#). This will take place on **Thursday 2nd October** during the morning of the school day. As such there will be no travel costs and minimised disruption to lessons. Year 8s will have the opportunity to experience their English text through a one-hour performance.
