YEAR 11 STUDY LEAVE FOR PUBLIC EXAMS - MAY/JUNE 2024

From the beginning of the summer term until study leave, lessons will be focussed on revision topics. Study leave for your son (when he may revise for his exams at home) will run as below. I have included some other details for your information.

- Thursday 18th April GCSE Art exam
- Friday 19th April GCSE Art exam
- Thursday 2nd May GCSE Modern Language Speaking Exams
- Friday 3rd May GCSE Modern Language Speaking Exams
- Friday 3rd May Last teaching day. *Study leave begins at 1530.*
- Monday 6th May Bank Holiday
- Tuesday 7th May GCSE Modern Language Speaking Exams
- Wednesday 8th May GCSE Modern Language Speaking Exams
- 9th May – 26th June Public exams (includes the designated contingency days at the end of the period for which **all students must remain available**)
- Tuesday 25th June Book Return (all students) followed by Sixth Form Taster Day (for all those wishing to return to the RGS Sixth Form)
- Thursday 28th June Free at last!

Please note:

- **Whenever on school premises during the exam period your son should be in full school uniform as required for his year group.**
- Students will not be able to use the Library for revision as this area is used by other classes.
- Any student wishing to do private study in school up to May half term or after the Y7-10 school exam period should go to the classroom they would have been having a lesson in at that time.
- During School Exam Week immediately after half term private study areas will be extremely limited as there will be no access to any areas where internal school exams are being held.
- All school rules apply when you are in school. **This includes no use of mobile phones 0840-1530.**

Some students may wish to see their teachers during study leave so that they can receive clarification about material they have revised or to get a past paper marked. Up to half term Year 11 teachers will therefore be available in their classrooms or department areas at their usual teaching times for individual or group support. After half term, revision sessions may be arranged within departments. We encourage all boys to seek this support if they need it.

Year 11 are reminded that the Sixth Form Taster Day takes place on **Tuesday 25th June**. There will be taster lessons in three of the subjects your son has requested for A level. Attendance is compulsory for all those wishing to return in the Sixth Form.
