Dear Year 12 Parents and Students

Oxford University Open Day on Wednesday, 3rd July 2019

I am writing to inform you that Oxford University Open Day will be **Wednesday, 3rd July 2019**.

Year 12 pupils wishing to attend will need to arrive in Oxford by 10:00 and can expect to finish by 16:00. A suggestion would be to catch the train directly to Oxford from High Wycombe. It costs £14.20 with a train leaving High Wycombe at 09:06, arriving in Oxford at 09:47. The return train leaves Oxford at 16:11, arriving in High Wycombe at 16:50. We recommend that your son takes a packed lunch on the day although food can be purchased during his visit to Oxford.

If you feel that the cost involved is prohibitive, please do contact me in strictest confidence and I will see if there is funding available to assist you,
