### **Years 8 & 9 SCOTLAND EXPEDITION – KNOYDART PENINSULA - ONLINE INFORMATION EVENING**

We are delighted by the initial interest which was shown in the Knoydart expedition and as such would like to extend an invitation to attend an online information evening on **Wednesday 4th of December at 18:30**. This will be an opportunity to hear from a representative of the Living Project and to ask them any questions related to the trip. Following this, we will begin taking sign ups and deposits to secure places on the trip.

The trip has been costed as **£975** per a student and shortly following the information evening we will require a **30 % deposit of £292.50** in order to secure a spot on the expedition. Following this, the remaining balance will be paid off in monthly instalments. If there are any concerns or issues related to the cost of the expedition please don't hesitate to contact me and I can look into whether there may be any support available.

Provisionally we are planning to run the expedition between the **15/6/25 and the 21/6/25**. However, due to unexpected levels of sign up last year we are open to running a second expedition if there is sufficient interest. Therefore, we will not be able to provide final confirmation of the dates for the week-long expedition until places are allocated.

Please also do note that attendance at the evening is not a guarantee of a place on the trip but we will endeavour to provide the opportunity for as many students as possible to take part in this amazing opportunity. Depending on how much sign up we have, names may be drawn from a ballot to ensure place allocation is as fair as possible.
