We are pleased to announce a (free) Mock MMI (Multiple Mini Interview) Evening that we have organised with the kind support of our parent/volunteer Medic community. This event is designed to provide our students with invaluable experience and insights into the interview process they may encounter when applying to medical/vet schools in the highly competitive programmes that utilise the MMI format.

Details of the Mock MMI Evening: Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 17:00 to 19:00 (students will be required to stay at school after P8 to help with set up) in the Sixth Form Centre.

The MMI format assesses a candidate's communication skills, ethical reasoning, problem-solving abilities, and interpersonal skills through a series of short interview stations. This format can be challenging and unfamiliar to many students, which is why we believe that practising in a supportive and familiar environment is crucial to their success.

Participation in this free Mock MMI Evening is entirely optional, but we strongly encourage all eligible students to take advantage of this valuable opportunity. To register your child for this event, please complete <u>this</u> registration form by no later than Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> September. Spaces are limited, so we encourage you to register as soon as possible.

We believe that this Mock MMI Evening will be an enriching experience for our Year 13 students, helping them to build confidence and skills that will serve them well in their future academic and professional pursuits.
