**UCAS Exams Year 12
Study Leave 3-14 June 2019**

During the fortnight of Y12 UCAS exams your son will be sitting his end of year examinations. In this period there are two exam sessions each day which begin at 08.45 and 13.15. Boys have study leave for the entirety of this time but do not have any authorisation for study leave for these exams outside these two weeks. They must all return to school on **Monday 17 June**.

If your son comes into school to revise in the School Library, he **must** use the finger scanner to indicate his presence on site and again to indicate when he is leaving.

The contract school buses will depart from RGS at their usual times. Students must not remain in or around the school buildings where public exams are taking place as they could disturb those still sitting exams.

The exam timetable is attached with this letter and available on the school website.

Please note that we expect all boys to prepare fully and carefully for these exams. As all Year 12 students were told at the beginning of the academic year and have been reminded several times during the year, the results of these exams form the primary basis for their UCAS prediction. Getting their revision techniques right (and thus gaining exam results which show their full potential) is therefore absolutely essential. All boys should ensure they are clear about their exam topics, techniques and structure and should consult their subject teacher if they are in any doubt.
