"The Young Enterprise day was fun, but also made me think about what I wanted to do in the future, and where my strengths could be in running a business. It helped me understand all the different skills that are needed for the diverse roles when running a business, and how my skills could be used in the best, most effective way. I learnt how to craft an elevator pitch as a team, and how to present it in a captivating, convincing way. I also learned different things such as marketing, which I am happy our team won the award for."

**Awais**, a member of the team which won the Best Pitch and overall Best Company awards, with Muscle Monsters shared: "As a year group we were all looking forward to what this day will entail as there was a lot of buzz around it following the success from last year.

The year group was split into Teams and instructed to put together a plan after being given a theme. The theme we were given was 'gym'. Following this, each member in our team was allocated a role, which involved execution of our business plan. We came up with our company name 'Muscle Monsters' and the tagline 'Unleash your Inner Beast!' I was part of the Design team. My sole responsibility was the logo design, which I thoroughly enjoyed. We collaborated with other Teams to mutually benefit from our business ideas and the profits generated, after strong negotiations on both parts.

We had the opportunity to present our company to the panel explaining our business plan and ideas. I can proudly say 'Muscle Monsters' won two awards - Best Elevator Pitch and Best Business. There was some great talent displayed from the other teams and it was a tough competition. I learnt that to succeed, individual commitment to a group effort, is what makes a team work!

**Kiyan**, whose team. Ride for Life, did not win any of the awards, still made the most of the day. This is what he had to say: "The Young Enterprise Day was very enjoyable as we engaged in teamwork activities and strengthened our skills in working with different people . Adding to the excitement was the fact that we were off timetable for the whole day, doing different projects about to a new enterprise.

Though I wasn't part of a winning team, it was still a great opportunity for me. I developed a range of marketing skills and my role as Finance Director taught me to manage the money side of businesses. This experience showed me how Maths is used in everyday life, for example, working out the costs and profits of a company. I also developed more confidence in my presentation skills whilst pitching to the Dragons to get their buy-in in my team's - Ride for Life - bike and scooter company.

RGS has had a long-standing strategic partnership with Morrisby, a distinguished provider of psychometric testing services renowned for its precision and reliability.

Through Morrisby's suite of psychometric tests, students from Year 10 to Year 13 gain access to meticulously designed assessments that delve into their cognitive abilities, personality traits, and vocational interests.

How to sign up for the optional test:

Go to: https://app.morrisby.com/morrisby-pay?passedCode=p82J6A which will be valid for use until Monday 6th May 2024. Please make sure your son's school email address is used.

Upon payment, an email will be sent to the purchaser giving them a username and password for their child which can be used immediately. Once they have these details the student will need to go to <a href="https://www.morrisby.com">www.morrisby.com</a> and 'Log in' in the top right-hand corner of the screen using their username and password to get access to the initial screen they need to complete prior to taking the assessments. From here they will be guided through the process. The Morrisby Profile does not need to be taken at any particular time and does not need to be completed in one session.

## NATIONAL CAREERS WEEK

RGS enthusiastically embraced National Careers Week in mid-March with a diverse array of school-wide activities aimed at fostering career exploration and development among students.



Through our partnership with the Buckinghamshire Skills Hub, all students (Y7 to Y13) participated in a virtual webinar focusing on Labour Market Information. During the session, they gained insights into various local opportunities and pathways available to them. Our aim was to dispel stereotypes and broaden awareness of the multitude of options accessible to them, empowering them to make informed decisions about their next steps.



A Unifrog Workshop offered Y12 students valuable insights into exploring career opportunities and university searches. Through active participation, students deepened their understanding of the UK job market, explored diverse career paths available, dived into higher education/apprenticeship routes, and sharpened their proficiency in utilising Unifrog's tools to chart their career paths effectively. By attending the workshop, students gained the expertise and resources needed to make well-informed decisions about their future endeavours within the career landscape.



The DfE Y7 Future Skills Questionnaire, offered students a great opportunity to reflect on their career-related knowledge and skills. It helped inform continuous improvement on pathway knowledge and next-steps options awareness. Through self-reflection and raising aspirations students could identify strengths and areas to work on early on, enabling the Careers Department to align curriculum activities with career skills, ensuring a more relevant and beneficial learning experience.
