Our June Open Days are moving online and we will be running a range of University-wide and subject specific activities for prospective students from Monday 22 June to Friday 26 June.

We will be running over 200 webinars across the week, with subject areas showcasing on different days, as well as key presentations and content from our support services available all week. Prospective students will have the opportunity to ask questions in the webinars and interact with students and academics in our live chat sessions.

Shape Your Future: Webinar and Academic Interview Series

Our [live webinars](#) are for school/college students who are thinking of applying to university. Hear from our Student Recruitment and Outreach Teams about a range of university related topics including the benefits of Higher Education, how to choose a university and course, tips for writing personal statements, student finance and student life. Each webinar will feature a presentation with an opportunity for students to ask questions.
