## Students

- Please ensure that all students have adequate sun protection and water bottles.
- Students will have school/packed lunch as normal.
- All break and lunchtime sporting activities will be cancelled.
- Interact (Sixth Formers) will be selling donuts to raise money for charity throughout the day (cash or card).
- The PA will also have a supply of refreshments for purchase in the afternoon (cash or card).
- In the event of bad weather, Sports Day will be adapted and communicated accordingly.

## Spectators

- Spectators are invited to attend the afternoon events from **2pm**.
- Entry to the school will be via the Boarding Gate Entrance on Green Road (HP13 5LH) and all parents must sign in there. Please note there will be no pedestrian access to Sports Day via the entrance on Hamilton Road.
- Please park considerately on the residentials roads surrounding the school.
- Spectators are encouraged to bring picnics to enjoy in the area in front of the cricket pavilion.
- The PA will also have a supply of refreshments for purchase in the afternoon (cash or card).
- Spectator toilet facilities will be available in the cricket pavilion.
