## Dear Parent/Guardian

Your son will be continuing a PSHCE (Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education) course. There will be four modules: Citizenship, Relationships and two Careers Modules.

I believe this course to be an important part of the curriculum as it gives boys opportunities to develop an understanding of themselves and others by:

- exploring attitudes and feelings
- acquiring knowledge and developing skills
- appreciating a range of values
- acknowledging the effects of their actions
- learning to give and receive support

There will be 25 PSHCE lessons throughout the year and in Year 11 the course will include the following themes:

- The Media
- Good Citizenship
- Human Rights
- Government Finances
- Emotions Stress, Grief
- Relationships
- Sex Education and Sexual Health
- Child Sex Exploitation
- Testicular Cancer
- Choices at 16+/18+
- Higher Education
- Gap year opportunities
- Student finance

You do have the legal right to withdraw your son from Sex Education lessons which are not part of the Science National Curriculum. However, as a school we are committed to the broad development of boys and the content of the course is considered very carefully bearing in mind the boys' age, family backgrounds, society values and the values of the school.
