Dear Parent/Carer,

### **Royal Grammar School – 28th January 2026**

Your child is now due their Year 9 secondary school vaccinations to protect them against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio (Td/IPV), Meningitis ACWY, and, if needed, Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR). These are important boosters to keep your child safe from serious illnesses.

#### **What to do:**

- Consent online: : [TDIPV MenACWY Vaccination Consent Form \(buckschildimmunisations.co.uk\)](http://TDIPV MenACWY Vaccination Consent Form (buckschildimmunisations.co.uk))
- Please fill in the online consent form by midday on 27/01/2026 using the school code **EE136484**.
- If you can't get online, call the immunisation team and we'll help you over the phone.

Vaccinations will take place at your child's school on **28/01/2026**. Without consent, your child may not be vaccinated. If your child wishes to have the vaccine and you haven't given consent, we may check if they can consent themselves.

#### **Vaccine details:**

- Td/IPV (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio): A booster is needed in Year 9 for full protection. Given as a single injection.
- MenACWY: Protects against four types of meningitis and is given as a single injection at the same time as the Td/IPV booster.
- MMR: Two doses are needed for protection. If your child missed either of these doses, we can catch them up during the session.
