Year 7 Parents' Meeting – Tuesday 19 March 2019

A Parents' Meeting for boys in Year 8 is being held on **Tuesday 19 March 2019** in the **Queen's Hall** from **16:15-18:45**. We believe it is beneficial for your son to be present and we invite you to come with him to this occasion. As this is a formal school occasion students are expected to attend in full school uniform. There will be 5 minute timed interviews with teaching staff with a 15 minute break at 17:20.

We use an on-line booking system for Parents' Meetings so that you can book directly with teachers using the following link: https://rgshw.parentseveningsystem.co.uk/

The booking system will be available for you to make appointments from 19:00 on Tuesday 5 March – please note the system is not open for bookings before this date and time.

To address concerns about a lack of availability of appointments we manage the booking of appointments in the following way. Initially, you can only book a **maximum number of 3 appointments per boy** so would advise you to prioritise appointments in subjects where there are concerns. **Please book your appointments as early as possible as some teachers may be oversubscribed.** If a member of staff teaches your son in more than one subject please only book a single appointment with that teacher.

At 07:30 on Friday 8 March you will be able to book another 3 appointments. We will send you a reminder nearer the time. Please remember to bring your appointment schedule with you to the meeting.

The booking system will close at **23:55 on Friday 15 March.** You will not be able to make any appointments after this date and time.

We hope you find this system effective. We have attached a brief user guide to this letter and would be particularly grateful if you could note the information regarding logging in details.
