STEM subjects

Along with this letter you are receiving a leaflet which will be of particular relevance for those of you who have sons interested in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) subjects. It details a programme for Year 9 and Year 10 students who are interested in routes they can take towards their STEM career. It is designed to give students an insight into pathways following GCSE's including study routes via University, College and direct Apprenticeship routes through industry. It is suitable for all academic abilities - all that is required is a genuine interest in STEM subjects and inquisitiveness about what the future can hold. The programme requires 20 hours of study to be completed over 2 weeks, inclusive of half term. This allows students to study flexibly at a pace that suits their individual circumstances.

The course cost is £60 towards the cost of administration and the Industrial Cadets Bronze award. Bursary places are available, please refer to the application form. The deadline is **31st January**.
