both BOYS and GIRLS from 4pm, starting in Room 12

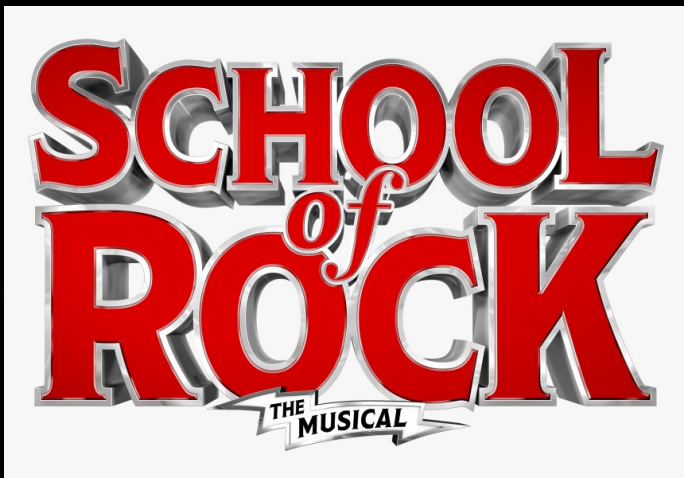

- Please scan the QR code and fill in the linked application form if you wish to audition.



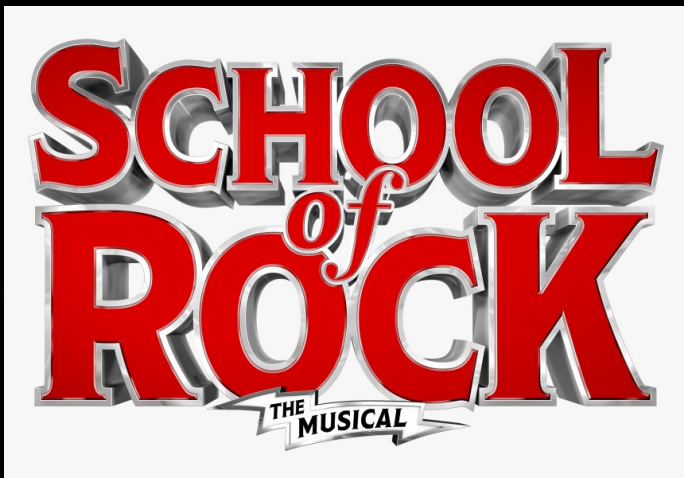


What happens at the audition?

YEARS 7-10 | SUNDAY 13 MARCH

BOYS 10-1.30PM | GIRLS 2-5.30PM

- **MOVEMENT/ DANCE:** We will teach you a bit of movement with a song from the show and then you will perform this in groups.
- **SINGING:** You'll learn a section of a song from the show and you'll be asked to sing a short section on your own
- **ACTING:** You will be asked to read a section of script provided on the day. You may be asked to read again with a different accent, or with a different given direction.
- **INSTRUMENTS:** Many of the characters in the show play a live instrument. It is possible to perform all of the roles even if you don't play an instrument but please do make sure you let us know if you do, and **BRING** it along to auditions please! Be prepared to play a little something.



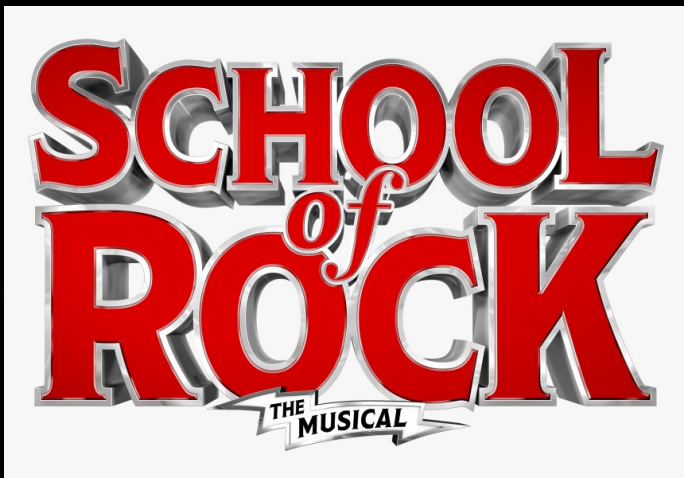
What happens at the audition?

YEARS 11-13 | THURSDAY 17 MARCH FROM 4PM

- **SINGING AUDITION:**

- Prepare a song of your own choice. You may choose any song (Ideally from a musical similar to School of Rock) that shows off voice and character.
- Try and cut the song to about 2 minutes long (or less)
- Bring your own sheet music for your song, or please bring a backing track.
- If you are auditioning for a lead role, it will be helpful if you are familiar with the songs that the character sings.
- Friendly advice: Please try and know your chosen song off by heart
- You may be asked to stop before you have finished the whole song. This could be for any number of reasons, please do not think it is a bad thing.

What happens at the audition?

- **ACTING AUDITION:**
 - You will be asked to read a section of script provided on the day
 - You may be asked to read again with a different accent, or with a different given direction
- **RECALL DATE TO BE CONFIRMED TBC**
- **WHO CAN AUDITION?**
 - Anyone from RGS and female identifying students from partner schools. Candidates who are interested in a lead or speaking role must do an individual audition which will include both acting and singing.
