An Insight into Apprenticeships

Email from RGS Leaver 2021, Jonathan Herath, BAE Systems Apprentice

"Currently I am undertaking a Project Management Degree Apprenticeship with BAE Systems, in conjunction with the University of Portsmouth. I am in the latter stages of my first of four and a half years on this scheme.

My Apprenticeship consists of completing yearly placements in different teams within a sector of the business. Alongside this, I am completing a tailored project management degree course. I spend four days a week working in my team and I spend the remaining day in university lectures or completing university studies.



Highlights for me have been the work trips and stretch activities I have been provided the opportunity to take part in. Additionally, travelling to Glasgow with my work team and my regular travel to Portsmouth has been a fantastic



experience. On a more personal note, despite not being at university full time, I have not found that my social life has suffered. Due to the good number of apprentices BAE employ each year I have been able to make several very good friends my age at work. Also, I am not too swamped to be unable to go out on weekends. This is because of the tailoring of the degree course meaning we are required to do less work than a full-time degree. This is not to say that the apprenticeship is easy; a good attitude and resilience is required. There is also far less free time compared to your average student, especially when considering the number of holiday days companies offer. Equally



though, there is far less debt and job uncertainty that I take on as an apprentice. Namely, I get paid for my work and degree, and by the end of the scheme am essentially guaranteed a job if I would like one with the company I got experience with for the previous five years."
