Be as creative as you want on any subject matter, feel free to edit as you see fit, use of post-production software is allowable along with HDR, double exposure, time-lapse, filters or any other means of image editing.

- Each pupil can submit up to two photos maximin, split any way you prefer, ie: two entries into the "Autumn Nature" category or one entry into the "#PositiveChange" category and one into the "Life on Lockdown 2.0" category etc.
- Each image must be saved as a JPG file and not exceed 5 mb in size.
- File name must be the category, full name followed by your form, then image title for example "Autumn Nature-John Smith-10AJ-Trees on Hill"
