Dear Parents

I am writing to update you on the upcoming 12-15 year old COVID-19 vaccination programme mentioned by the Headmaster in his letter earlier this week.

We have been allocated Wednesday 29th September and will have a team of 25 nurses coming to RGS to support the programme. I would like to stress that we are merely providing a location for the vaccinations and are therefore acting as a vaccination centre; we are not providing any advice or guidance regarding vaccinations – this is voluntary and requires consent from you as parents or the student themselves.

Please may I ask if you have not already done so, that you complete the [e-consent form](#) that was sent out earlier this week. I would like to stress that whilst the vaccination program is an essential component to reducing community transmission, students will not be pressured into receiving a vaccination.

To help facilitate the smooth running of the day, we ask that students in years 8, 9, 10 and 11 come to school in their games kit. This will ensure that the process of vaccination will not be hindered by the removal of ties and unbuttoning of shirts etc.
