Dear Year 12 Parents/Guardians,

University of Exeter Education Partnership

We shared details of a partnership with the University of Exeter with our Year 12 students at the recent Higher Education Day. The partnership is for the next academic year and is between the School and the University, but there are some points you might like to be aware of:

- Students at RGS will be able to access resources provided by the University of Exeter, including live talks and advice, information and guidance on submitting their UCAS application.
- RGS staff will receive early notice of when bookings for events like Open Days on their 3 campuses become available.
- Students from RGS who apply for an **uncapped course** during this cycle (2021/22) will receive a guaranteed offer from the University of Exeter. If an offer is made it will be in line with entry requirements on the website and UCAS hub - students will still need to meet additional requirements (such as a grade in a particular subject) where specified. RGS will have a list of what constitutes a capped course. This currently includes courses such as Medicine and subjects with a study abroad component. Exeter are in the process of finalising the list of capped courses for 2022 entry. This list cannot be circulated to parents but students can find out if a course they are interested in is on the list by contacting Mrs Azad (sva@rgshw.com).
- Students at RGS will have many opportunities to ask questions to University of Exeter staff to help them make an informed choice about their next steps, whatever they choose to go on to do.
