- Attend every lesson
- Arrive on time
- Bring all the books and equipment you need
- Put bags and coats away tidily
- Put Homework Diaries on the desk at the start of lessons (Years 7 – 11)
- Begin and end the lesson in a polite and orderly way
- Listen to others and expect to be listened to
- Follow instructions
- Work diligently
- Ask for help from the teacher when you need it
- Help each other when it is appropriate but don't distract or annoy anyone
- Put your hand up to answer a question
- Speak politely
- Eating is not permitted in classrooms or inside school buildings other than in designated areas such as the Restaurant.
- Keep the classroom clean and tidy
