Student loan repayment threshold increase

Once students leave their course, they will only repay their course fees when their income is above the repayment threshold. As of 6 April 2021, the UK threshold for Plan 2 loans (all FE loans and post-2012 HE loans) rose to £27,295 a year (£2,274 a month, £524 a week).
