knowledge, and mindset to learn about social entrepreneurship. The last Camstart programme had over 200 students from around the world, and the Camstart team would like to extend an invitation to students from RGS for our November Cohort. The CAMSTART Programme aims to empower students to launch social impact projects by equipping them with the relevant skills and knowledge. It is developed with the guidance of successful social entrepreneurs with experience building million-dollar businesses and social innovation experts from The Global Development Incubator and UNICEF. Students in the programme can spend 3-4 hours per week over 6 weeks going through masterclasses, 1-on-1 meetings with Cambridge student mentors, and live webinars delivered by social innovation experts.
