Dear Year 12 Students and Parents

Year 12 UCAS Higher Education Exhibition Trip – Tuesday 22nd March 2022

In order to aid your information gathering process for Higher Education post 18, we have booked 150 places for Year 12 students to attend the UCAS Higher Education Exhibition at Farnborough International Exhibition & Conference Centre (with stunning views of the airfield!) on **Tuesday 22nd March 2022**. Coaches will leave RGS at **09.40am promptly from Green Road** and are expected to return at approximately 14.30pm. This exhibition plays a vital part in helping applicants decide what and where to study within Higher Education as well as providing information about other destinations post 18. As well as universities, colleges, apprenticeship providers and employers ready to help you discover your future, the exhibition is due to include:

- Live application clinics and personal statement workshops
- Course and careers taster sessions
- Student talks and Q&As
- Expert advice on how to research and choose what's right for you
- The chance to explore and meet unis, colleges and employers face-to-face
- ... plus lots more

Everyone going to the exhibition will receive a copy of the 2022 APPLY book, produced by Pure Potential. This is an extremely popular Sixth Form guide and has proved invaluable to RGS students in previous years. It gives advice on applying to university, school leaver opportunities and careers help.

Within the terms of the School's policy on charging, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£15.00** to cover the cost of the trip. No student will be prevented from taking part in the visit on the grounds that a contribution cannot be made, but if insufficient funding is available, the visit may be cancelled. If you feel that the cost involved is prohibitive, please do contact me, in strictest confidence, and I will see if there is funding available to assist you.

Parents: If you wish your son to take part in the trip, and we warmly encourage Y12 students to attend this convention, **please log onto Parent Pay, look up the "UCAS Yr12 Higher Education Exhibition" and pay the full amount of £15.00 by Friday 14th January.** If you are unable to pay online, please contact the Finance Office to pay by an alternative method. Please note that, if your son drops out of the trip, we will be unable to provide a refund unless he finds someone to take his place.

Please note that every year, students come to see us at the last moment requesting to be included on the trip and it is not possible to include them. If you want to attend you must submit your request by or before the deadline.

PLEASE ALSO BE AWARE THAT THESE PLANS MAY BE SUBJECT TO SHORT NOTICE CHANGES OR CANCELLATION DUE TO UPDATES IN COVID GUIDANCE OR ISOLATION PROCEDURES. Students should know that, as part of this registration, they will need to opt in to receive additional information from universities, colleges and employers. This could be invitations to open days, prospectuses, or relevant course or opportunity vacancies.
