Dear Students and Parents,

After hugely successful performances of "School of Rock" last July, the RGS Music Department is delighted to officially announce exciting plans for a senior production of "The Producers", to be staged live in the Queen's Hall (Wednesday 22^{nd} – Saturday 25^{th} March 2023). We have selected this show in part to contrast with our previous RGS musicals, and in order to provide plenty of opportunities for students to audition and gain a huge amount of experience, regardless of whether they have performed on stage before or not.

We envisage this show to be a Senior production due to the themes explored (the musical has a '12' age rating according to Musical Theatre International), and will therefore cast Seniors in named roles. However, we would welcome auditions from Junior students who would like an ensemble or featured dancer part, in advance of a more senior role in a future production.

The original Broadway production garnered a record-breaking 12 Tony awards, though many may also be familiar with Mel Brooks' 1967 film or the more recent 2005 adaptation. In this comedy, we follow two theatrical producers, Max Bialystock and Leo Bloom, who scheme to get rich by fraudulently overselling interests in a Broadway flop, which unexpectedly turns out to be successful.

I am delighted to invite back and work alongside Becky Harrison, a professional director and choreographer, who has directed our previous productions of "School of Rock", "In The Heights" and "West Side Story", whilst also being heavily involved in the local Trinity Theatre Arts school that takes place onsite.
