Theatre Experience: Vulture Society

For many years, the RGS English Department has offered membership of the 'Vulture Society' to all who are interested in the theatre, music, and the visual arts. Our aim is to provide RGS students with as broad a cultural experience as possible, and Senior Vulture offers a variety of theatre visits to achieve this objective. Each year, Sixth Formers are invited to see theatrical performances, ranging from popular theatre to the classics: from Jonathan Lewis' 'Our Boys', to Shakespeare's tragic tale of 'Othello'. These valuable cultural experiences can be useful for UCAS applications and interviews, and are open to all Sixth Formers, not just A Level English Literature students.

This year we are planning to offer the next best thing: a pop-up theatre experience at RGS, from the comfort of the English classrooms! We will offer the theatre showings this year on a pay-as-you-go basis, rather than the usual package deal for three productions across the year.

The first opportunity is taking place **next week, Thursday 26th November**, where we will be streaming the Olivier Award-nominated production of Morgan Lloyd Malcolm's hit 'Emilia', originally staged in the Globe Theatre in 2018.

Please purchase your £2.50 'ticket' and sign up through ParentPay. The ticket sales ('Vulture Theatre 1 at RGS') will close on Tuesday 24th November at 7pm.

The pop-up theatre showing will take place next Thursday 26th November at 4pm in Rooms 26 and 27. Year 12 will be in one room and Year 13 in another, making the event COVID-compliant. We expect to be finished at 6.30pm. Feel free to bring a snack and a drink.
