Personal Statement & Interview Clinics

She has given Personal Statement advice and practice interviews to thousands of students, including medics, Oxbridge and Russell Group applicants, across the full range of subject areas. She is frequently invited to speak at conferences as an expert on statements, references and interviews and is also the voice of the Personal Statement video on the UCAS website.
