

## Is you child in Year 8?

They are now eligible for their first HPV vaccination

## Is your child in Year 9?


Second dose HPV is now due. If they missed their first dose in year 8, it is not too late. They are also eligible for their final Tetanus, Diphtheria and Polio and Meningitis vaccine.



The School Immunisation team are currently running the HPV vaccination programme for BOTH boys and girls in year 8. This is a 2dose programme with their first dose given in year 8 and a second dose in year 9. It's not too late to consent!

## Yr 9's Teenage Td/IPV Booster and MenACWY

During May '22 we will be starting the year 9 booster vaccinations. Please fill out the consent forms using the E-consenting platform. Your school will send out the links in due course.
