Re: AQA GCSE Physical Education Non-Examined Assessment – Written

I am writing to inform you that your son will be starting his written Non-Examined Assessment: ***Analysis and Evaluation of Performance***. This assessment accounts for 25 % of his Non-Examined Assessment grade, which equates to 10 % of his overall Physical Education grade. The first submission deadline for this work is **Thursday 26th May 2022 at 17.00 via Microsoft Teams**.

Your son will be briefed each week on the weekly task to be completed. Your son will need to complete each section during his double Physical Education theory lesson as well as part of his weekly homework. To monitor your son's weekly progress of this work, he will be required to upload each section to the relevant weekly assignment posted on Microsoft Teams, in advance of his single Physical Education GCSE lesson the following week.
