Year 12 Enrichment Day - 16th September 2022

RGS are excited to be able to offer an Enrichment Day on Friday 16th September for Year 12 students to learn about leadership styles and how to transfer leadership skills to all areas of their lives.

The day is designed to help students build confidence, develop practical leadership skills, and understand the importance of teamwork. Students will be off timetable for the duration of the day and take part in a series of teambuilding, practical and physical challenges which will take place on Uplyme playing field.

Along with RGS staff we will be joined by a number of professionally qualified staff from Wilderness Expertise to help facilitate the delivery of the day.

There will be a cost involved in the running of the Enrichment Day which the School is already subsidising in order to support students. Within the terms of the School's policy on charging, I am writing to ask for your agreement to your son taking part in this event and to ask for a voluntary contribution of **£20** so that we can cover some of the costs incurred. No pupil will be prevented from taking part in the activities on the grounds that parents cannot or will not make such a contribution, but if insufficient funding is available, the event may be cancelled. If you feel that the cost involved is prohibitive, please do contact me in strictest confidence and I will see if there is any funding available to assist you.
