Chemistry support work

The end of term, like most of the year, has been rather disrupted so this letter and accompanying support work is being sent to all Year 9 parents.

If your son was awarded a Grade 3 or above in the End of Year Exam, please feel free to disregard this letter, unless you or your son think it would be worthwhile to do a bit of further study to consolidate this grade. If your son was awarded either a Grade 2 or Grade 1 in the recent End of Year Chemistry examinations, this shows that some further learning (in addition to the in-lesson review) would be beneficial.

In order to support him as he continues with his GCSE studies, this letter is accompanied by some extra work to complete before September. In September, markschemes will be available and your son should bring the work along to one of the support clinics (times to be advertised in September) so that he can review it under the supervision of the Chemistry Subject Ambassadors.

If your son was awarded a Grade 1 or 2, I would be grateful if you could speak to him about the importance of engaging with this support work and assist him in finding some time to do it during the summer break.
